Dress Code 2017-2018

Purpose: The purpose of our dress code is to encourage appropriate clothing that promotes Christian values and an academic environment. The development of habits of neatness, good grooming, and following directions are goals that should be a part of the education of every student.

Pants

- Solid navy blue or khaki dress pants

Shorts and Skorts

- Solid navy blue or khaki dress shorts/skorts/capris with belt loops
- Must be at least knee-length
- Worn only in August, September, May
- White, black, or navy blue socks when shorts/skorts are worn

Shirts

- Solid navy blue or white polo with collar
- Must be an appropriate size, length, and remain tucked in
- Matching, solid navy blue or white shirt may be worn under polo

Sweaters and Sweatshirts

- Solid navy blue or white sweaters or sweatshirts without hoods
- Must be worn over school shirt

Shoes

- Black and/or white tennis shoes (no other colors may be visible)
- Solid black dress shoes
- Tennis shoes must be worn for gym class

Items NOT appropriate: (not exhaustive):

- Excessive: jewelry, hairstyles, make-up, etc.
- Cargo pants or shorts
- Boots, heels, flip flops of any kind
- Hoodies/jackets in the classrooms
- Visible undergarments
- Bandanas of any color
- Tight-fitting clothing

Acceptable dress down attire includes only: jeans, sweatpants, shorts/skirts (in season), school appropriate shirt and your choice of shoes (no boots, heels, or flip flops).

*If a serious problem or emergency arises and a student is unable to comply with dress code regulations, the student must bring a note of explanation to the office signed by a parent/guardian. A dress code permit will be issued to the student for one day only. Students not following dress code will be subject to disciplinary actions. These policies will be strictly enforced. **The principal retains the right to make a judgment regarding questionable dress of a student and changes to the above code.***
